The school management had been unsure if we could handle such large numbers, but as we left, they were already asking when we would return! Another positive outcome was that our head cook for the feeding programs was offered a job in their school kitchen during the week!

Two weeks later, on Saturday, July 20th, we partnered with the Tunedem Foundation for another event at Academia. This feeding program brought together 150 students for a lively music session, a Bible lesson, and a shared meal. 

In July, our School Ministry program visited several schools, including Elyons Academy where we minister 40 children, Joy Spring to Educational Centre with 240 students, St. Juliet Educational Centre with 135 students, and K.A.G. Primary School with 480 students totaling to 895 children every week. At each school, our staff and volunteers had the opportunity to share the gospel and connect with students.

With the arrival of the August school break, we paused our regular school ministry activities and redirected our efforts to other programs such as BTS, Shamiri Girls, and Listen Up, ensuring that the holiday period was filled with meaningful activities. With a month off from school and many parents busy trying to make ends meet, it is important to offer programs where young people have a place to go and something to do.

On Monday, August 12th, a Nairobi team of staff and volunteers arrived in Kadongo, Homabay, for the Kadongo Boys and Girls Conference. Hosted by John and Chami, the group included Brian, Geoffrey, Rodgers, Cynthia, and Luciano, led by George and his wife, Alice. The week was carefully structured, beginning with two days focused on ministering to the girls through morning devotions, Bible lessons, games, and Q&A sessions. Meanwhile, the men took charge of meal preparations, ensuring timely breakfasts and lunches.


On Thursday and Friday, the roles reversed, with the men leading activities for the boys and the women managing the kitchen. This approach allowed the team to effectively reach out to about 150 young people. The theme for the week was "Identity." We addressed questions like, "Who am I?" "Why am I here?" "Who do I look to?" and "Who can I become in Christ?"

As a parting gift, the ladies received gift packs containing sanitary towels, innerwear, toothpaste, and toothbrushes, while the men were given boxers, crocs, toothpaste, and toothbrushes.

We are so grateful for the team who served and pray that a lasting impression has been made on these young people. In a place where mentors and good examples are scarce and negative influences are rife, we pray that the light of Jesus continues to shine, drawing lives to the Savior!

THE 2024 NAIROBI GIRLS' Conference




